known as CFNZ, is a UK charity, based in Anglesey We welcome support of any kind, and your prayers please. CFNZ became a registered charity in May 2014.

Apart from bank and postage charges, all of the money raised goes to Fr. Tim for his work with the poor in rural areas of Zimbabwe.

Fr Tim helps children and the poor with the needs they have. He has, over the years, sourced funding for the construction of several primary and secondary schools, over 20 dams and a new hospital. Although he constructs these buildings with his own builders the local people help with their free labour. He is always looking for financial help for these needy projects.

CFNZ supplies funds for : Education and training; the advancement of health and relief of poverty; religious activities; community development including building, and employment, for all ages, within the general public.

In October 2023, 39 vulnerable children and two college students received an education, accommodation and food; 4 people on average are taken to hospital or clinics every week; 35 needy families received food aid. Fuel, food, an egg and sewing project and domestic wages for 14 adults, make up the rest of the budget.

Fr Tim Peacock, a secular Roman Catholic priest lives in Makwa and has 24 Outcentres. He was born in the UK, went to a seminary in Ireland, moving to Zimbabwe in 1985. There were 30 Christians in one centre, Makwa then, now there are about 300.
